BEACH PRESERVATION AND FLOOD PROTECTION PRACTICES AND PROCEDURES

Location: DNREC office conference room at 901 Pilottown Road, Lewes, DE 19958 (near the University of Delaware’s College of Marine Studies)

This field trip will be led by Tony Pratt, Shoreline and Waterways Program Administrator and Mike Powell, Flood Mitigation Program Manager at DNREC – Division of Watershed Stewardship.

This informative half day program will feature the following agenda:

- Introduction and overview of beach preservation and flood control initiatives in Delaware’s coastal areas at the DNREC office in Lewes.
- Field visit to the groin project at Herring Point in Cape Henlopen
- Field visit to a beach replenishment/preservation project in Fenwick Island
- FEMA flood hazard mitigation initiatives in the Town of Fenwick Island – homes were elevated through a FEMA, State and Town partnership
- Sand By-Pass System at Indian River Inlet – this system pumps sand from the south side of the inlet to the north side of the inlet to stabilize and replenish the beach and shoreline under and near the Indian River Bridge.

There is no charge for DE-AWRA members and \$10.00 for non-members.
DNREC will have two vans available to transport the group around to the tour locations.

Registration is due by close of business on Friday, October 28th. Carpooling is encouraged. Snacks and water will be provided during the field trip. Two state vehicles will be available in Lewes to take the group on the field tours, depending on the number registered.
