10:00 **Cool Springs Reservoir** **City of Wilmington**

The City of Wilmington's Cool Springs Reservoir was constructed in 1877. The reservoir is currently an open-air reservoir and it has been decided after a long discussion period that the reservoir should be enclosed. Construction work has begun on the Cool Springs reservoir reconstruction project, one of the City's largest water-related projects estimated at approximately \$24 million. Completion is scheduled for December 2007. The improvements include major infrastructure modifications and a landscaping beautification effort. The City of Wilmington Public Works Department and the project consultants will provide a brief overview and onsite tour.

Directions:

The group will convene at 10:00 am at the construction trailer, located on N. Jackson Street, between Park Place and 10th streets in Wilmington. If coming from points south, take I-95N to the Delaware Avenue Exit (exit #7). After exiting I-95, turn left on route 52, turn right on N. Van Buren St., right on Gilpin Avenue, and right on N. Jackson St. The construction trailer is located on N. Jackson St. at the end of the driveway between Park Place and 10th St. There is limited parking available in the lot next to the trailer, if the lot is full on-street parking is available on 10th St.
