A vacancy exists at the Baltimore County Soil Conservation District for a Soil Conservation Technician. An interview referral list will be established based on evaluation of background as stated on application materials received.

Required Qualifications

Possession of a four (4) year degree in Environmental, Physical, Conservation/Natural Resources Science or related field. Additional qualifying experience may be substituted on a year-for-year basis for the required education. Students currently enrolled in one of the fields listed may be considered. Experience with CADD is required.

Description of Duties

This position is technical work, which involves a working knowledge of soil and water conservation principles, practices and methods, and engineering. The aspects involve survey, design, layout, and construction check of project installation. Work is done in conjunction with the agricultural land owner or operator. This position assists the Baltimore County Soil Conservation District in the design and implementation of agricultural Best Management Practices (BMPs).

Equipment used in this position includes hand level, auto level, rod, transit, theodolite total station, two way radio, computer, truck, copy machine, planimeter, calculator, laser and inkjet printers, and fax machine. Also used in this position are various networked and personal computer systems including programs such as MS Word, MS Excel, Ohio, TR-55, and GIS systems such as Arc GIS and Property View. Need to have experience in using CADD.
